Students eligible for Chafee Education and Training Voucher/Chafee ETV for the 2022-2023 academic year will receive funding provided through the Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS).

The maximum award amount is \$5,000 for the 2022-2023 academic year. Students attending the fall and spring semester will be eligible for \$2,500 for each semester. Students attending a school on the quarter system will receive \$1,666.66 / \$1666.67/\$1,666.67 per term. Summer awards may be granted provided the student has not used his/her maximum award during the academic year.

The maximum age limitation on eligibility for assistance is 26 for the 2022 federal fiscal year. A student who is 26 will be eligible to receive a Chafee ETV grant for the fall semester/quarter of 2022 if he/she does not turn 27 prior to disbursement, provided that the student meets all other eligibility requirements.

The payment process for the Chafee ETV will not change.
