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Louisiana's GO Grant Program

This affidavit should be completed only if the GO Grant Applicant does not report Louisiana as his/her state of legal residence on the FAFSA.

To meet the Louisiana residency requirement for the GO Grant, the <u>dependent student</u> GO Grant Applicant must have one parent whose state of legal residence was Louisiana on the date the federal processor received the Applicant's FAFSA. The dependent student's state of legal residence is always that of his/her parent.

To meet the Louisiana residency requirement for the GO Grant, the <u>independent student</u> GO Grant Applicant's state of legal residence must have been Louisiana on the date the federal processor received the Applicant's FAFSA.

"State of Legal Residence" generally means the state you live in and that you intend to be your home state. Your intent is evidenced by where you reside and where you are registered to vote, obtain a driver's license, register your car and pay income taxes. For the GO Grant Program,

- For a dependent student, it is student's parent's true, fixed, and permanent home state. If the student's parents are separated or divorced, the noncustodial parent's true, fixed, and permanent home state may be used. If the student's parent is residing in a state for the sole purpose of attending a school, that state is not his/her legal residence.
- For independent students, it is your true, fixed, and permanent home state. If you are residing in a state for the sole purpose of attending a school, that state is not your legal residence.

SECTION BY SECTION INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING AFFIDAVIT OF RESIDENCY Please complete the affidavit and sign it in blue or black ink before a Notary Public.

- A. The parent of a dependent GO Grant Applicant or the independent student GO Grant Applicant must complete this form.
- B. Enter the name of the parent, or your name if you are an independent student.
- C. Enter the name and social security number of the GO Grant Applicant.
- D. Enter the name of the college or university the GO Grant Applicant has enrolled or will enroll in and the city and state in which it is located.
- E. Complete this Section if you are an Independent Student. If your Student Aid Report (SAR) indicates you are an independent student, no further documentation is required. Otherwise, you must furnish written confirmation of the determination from your financial aid officer or documentary proof of the reason you have checked. If you are have completed an undergraduate degree and are enrolled in a graduate program (studying for a masters and/or doctorate degree) or in a professional program (law, medical, veterinary, dental, etc.) you are not eligible for a Pell Grant or the GO Grant.
- F. See the definition of "state of legal residence" above. Insert the name of your "state of legal residence" as of the date of this affidavit and fill in the date that state first became your "state of legal residence." If you have been TEMPORARILY transferred out of Louisiana by your employer, you may still claim Louisiana as your state of legal residence if you maintain Louisiana as your residence while out of Louisiana and intend to return to Louisiana upon completion of your transfer. See the instructions for Section H below.
- G. Check <u>all</u> the boxes "Yes" or "No". If you check "YES" to question 2, 4, 6 or 8, you must attach <u>a copy</u> of the document listed after that item. At least one of the documents must show an issue date prior to the date the Applicant's FAFSA was received by the federal processor.  - The Louisiana Department of Motor Vehicles will provide information on how to obtain copies of your Louisiana vehicle registration. Call 877-368-5463 or visit http://www.dps.state.la.us/omv/hurricane.html.
 - 8. Louisiana Income Tax Return:
 - The Louisiana Department of Revenue will provide information on how to obtain copies of your state tax return. Call 225-219-0102.
- H. You must provide your current mailing address and telephone number. Please include your e-mail address if you have one. This information is essential to processing the Applicant's GO Grant application. It does not matter that you were not living in Louisiana on the date the Applicant's FAFSA was received by the federal processor, if you had been temporarily transferred out of Louisiana by your employer and had maintained your Louisiana residency. See the instructions for Section F above and for Section J below.
- I. If you were living outside Louisiana on the date the Applicant's FAFSA was received by the federal processor only because you were temporarily transferred out of Louisiana by your employer, you maintained your Louisiana residency, and you intend to return to Louisiana upon completion of your transfer, check the box and provide your employer's name, address and telephone number. To be a "temporary" transfer, the transfer out of Louisiana cannot be for more than twelve months. You must provide a letter from your employer that confirms your temporary transfer and the dates you were transferred out of Louisiana and the date you returned or will return to Louisiana. The letter must be on your employer's letterhead.
- J. You must sign the affidavit in front of a person who is a Notary in the state where you complete the affidavit.
