Program for Students (TOPS) and the Executive Director update.

Under New Business, it was proposed that the Advisory Board consider requests for

exception to the TOPS regulatory provisions that require students to remain continuously enrolled

and to earn the annual credit hours required during the academic year.

On motion of Dr. Henderson, seconded by Ms. Bailey, the LOSFA Advisory Board recommended that the Louisiana Board of Regents approve the requests for Madison (890919), John (979821), Jackson (1011520), Ashlei (999066), Harley (927801), Donte (983774), Logan (960498), Fatima (956207), Gavin (960875), Heba (943988), Braelyn (929413), Charles (938200), Sydney (945393), Logan (888669), Jon (982798), and Tarneisha (916130).

It was proposed that the Advisory Board consider the attached request for exception to the

TOPS statutory provision that requires a student to begin a home study program no later than the

conclusion of the tenth grade.

On motion of Ms. Bailey seconded by Mr. Estis, the LOSFA Advisory Board recommended that the Louisiana Board of Regents approve the request for Micah (1069457).

There being no further business, Ms. Hooper made a motion to adjourn at 12:20 p.m.,
