GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The “Applicant” is the student applying for a TOPS Award.
2. The “Affiant” is a parent or the court appointed custodian of the Applicant. An Affiant claiming to be a court ordered custodian must enclose a copy of the court document that establishes custody.
3. The Affiant must fill in all blanks and mark all appropriate blocks with a “✓” or an “X”. The Affidavit will not be accepted if it is not complete.
4. The Affidavit of Residency must be signed by the Affiant in blue or black ink in the presence of a Notary Public. The Affidavit will not be accepted if it is not signed or notarized.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

1. Sections A, B, and C: Fill in the requested information.
2. Section D: If the Applicant completed a BESE approved home study course, fill in the date of completion; otherwise insert “N/A” in the blanks.
3. Section E: If the Applicant graduated from an out-of-country high school, fill in the date of graduation; otherwise insert “N/A” in the blanks.
4. Section E: If the Applicant graduated from a high school, fill in the name of the high school and the name of the accrediting organization (Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, New England Association of Schools and Colleges, North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, Northwest Association of Accredited Schools, Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, Western Association of Schools and Colleges), otherwise insert “N/A” in the blanks.
5. Section F: Fill in the name of the city, state (territory, prefecture, or equivalent), and country in which the Applicant graduated from high school or completed the BESE approved home study program.
6. Answer each of the questions under Section G by marking either the “Yes” or “No” with either a “✓” or an “X”. **If you check “YES” to questions 1, 2, 3, or 4, you must attach a copy of at least one of the highlighted documents showing an issue date at least 24 months before the month of the date you enter in Section E. (Example: You were born in Louisiana and lived here until May 1995 when you moved to Tennessee. You resided in Tennessee until June 1998 when you moved back to Louisiana. You lived in Louisiana until you moved to another country in August 2010. You would fill the first blanks with June 1998 and the second blank with August 2010.)
You must attach a copy of each of the bolded documents in Section H. (Documents may include a Louisiana voters registration card, a Louisiana driver's license, a Louisiana registration for an owned vehicle, a Louisiana tax return, notarized affidavits, copies of correspondence from the employer or sponsor providing the reason for living outside the United States and its territories and the time period of the work or activity, copies of visas, copies of foreign housing documentation, and copies of other documents that demonstrate a presence in Louisiana or a foreign country during the required period of time. **If none of these documents meet that requirement, other documents may be acceptable. 8. In the presence of a Notary Public, sign and date the Affidavit.
9. After the Notary notarizes the Affidavit, send it with the required documents to the address listed above.
